HERE ARE SOME FUTURE GIVING OPTIONS FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION:

Your will or living trust

- You can give a specific dollar amount or a piece of personal or real property
- You can designate a percentage of your overall estate, which allows you to increase your gift as your assets increase without revising your will
- You can make a residual gift after other bequests are distributed
- You can name Larimer Humane Society as a contingent beneficiary for any of the above, in the event your primary beneficiary does not outlive you.

Life insurance policies

You can name Larimer Humane Society as the primary or secondary beneficiary of all or a portion of your life insurance policies. You also can make an outright gift during your lifetime of fully paid life insurance policies that you no longer need.

Retirement plans

You can name Larimer Humane Society as a primary or secondary beneficiary to receive all or a portion of the proceeds from retirement assets such as an IRA, 401k or 403b plan. Doing this does not require changing your will or trust and can usually be completed with a simple form.

You will want to work with an estate planning attorney or other financial professional to ensure you make the right choices for your circumstances. This information is not intended as legal advice and may not reflect current law.

PROTECTING YOUR PETS:

A key benefit of Heritage Circle membership is our Pet Guardianship program.

The program is available for members' pets, whether or not they were adopted from our shelter.

Under the program, Larimer Humane Society will provide temporary foster care, followed by permanent placement for up to three cats, dogs or other companion animals you may have at the time of your incapacity or death*. To enroll your pets, simply complete a "Pet Profile" for each animal, plus a "Pet Guardianship Notification" form and send them to us. You can submit additional pet profiles to enroll animals you adopt in the future.

Please notify your family, your attorney and your personal representative if you enroll pets in the Pet Guardianship program. You can do so by giving them copies of your "Pet Guardianship Notification" form and by including copies with your important personal records.
