A Letter From Our CEO & BOARD CHAIR



This spring marked two years since the COVID-19 pandemic first hit the United States. Though we're still learning to cope with our "new normal," we seem to be adapting to a world of uncertainty. For many of us, we've learned to adapt through focused efforts to infuse happiness, gratitude, and meaningful relationships into our lives. It may come as no surprise that, for us, pets have played a monumental role in that effort.

As the CEO and Board Chair of Larimer Humane Society, we not only derive joy from the pets in our lives, but also find fulfillment in service to the animals at the shelter. Fortunately for us, as we work toward the "return to normalcy," your partnership and support have allowed us to share in the joy of everyday victories for every animal welcomed through our doors.

Today, 17 dogs, 54 cats, and 62 critters fill the adoption hall, waiting for their second chance. One of the dogs — a German shepherd mix named Kaiser — hops excitedly in his kennel. Kaiser is receiving treatment for a medical condition called Pannus. This auto-immune disease affects the eyes, and results in scarring of the cornea. Left untreated, it causes blindness. Our veterinary staff diagnosed Kaiser during his intake exam and immediately started treatment, halting the progression of the disease, and preserving three-year-old Kaiser's eyesight.

Down the hall, a pair of Rex Rabbits named Calliope and Cinnamon are huddled together nibbling on a leaf of romaine. Calliope and Cinnamon were brought to the shelter together after their owner passed away. A caring neighbor was unsure of what to do with the two pets, but our staff assured them that bringing the two buns to Larimer Humane Society was the right thing to do in such a difficult situation.

In a nearby room, a five-year-old cat named Darla peaks out from the paper bag in her kennel. Darla

was missing 15 teeth when she was surrendered to us, and our veterinary staff noted that she was still suffering from severe tooth decay. She was quickly routed for surgery where six more teeth were extracted. After recuperating in a loving foster home, she's now healthy, and ready to live a much longer, more comfortable life with a new family.

This is just a snapshot in time; four of more than 6,000 animals; one of 365 days of constant care. In the scheme of things, Kaiser, Calliope, Cinnamon, and Darla's stories may not feel remarkable. But for each of them, and for their future families, these everyday moments will have lifelong meaning.

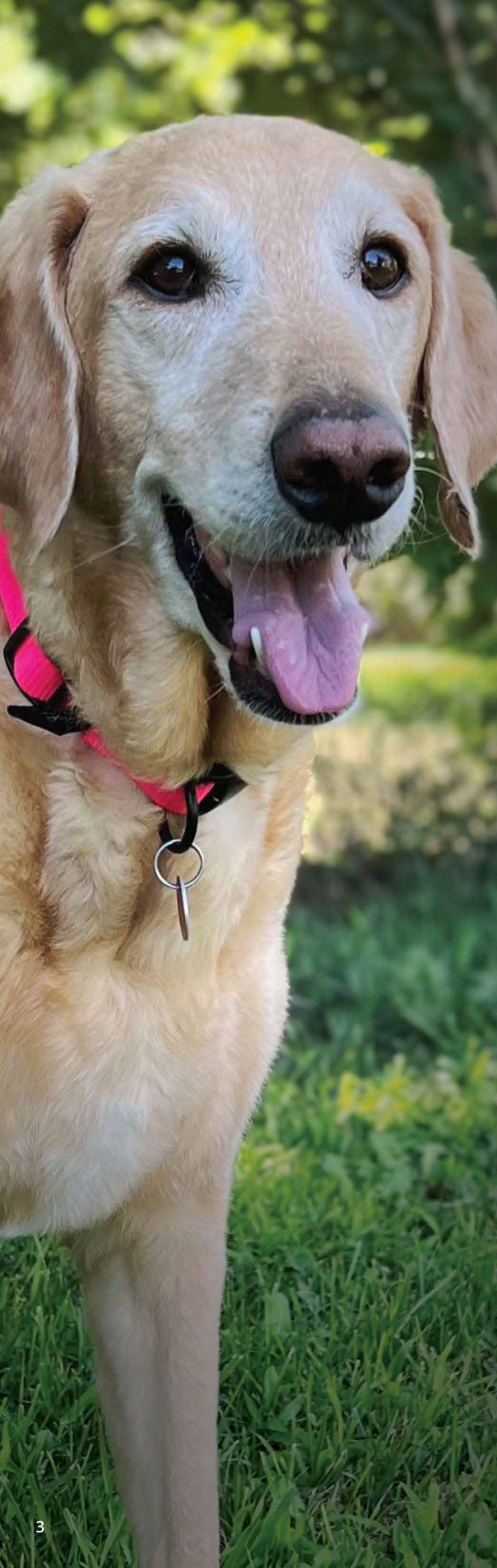
Understanding the monumental impact of everyday compassionate care is what inspired so many of this year's accomplishments. When our neighboring communities of Timnath and Berthoud sought support, we were thrilled to expand and provide full time Animal Control services and 24/7 emergency assistance. When employee shortages were rampant, it inspired an investment in our staff salaries and a significant increase to our starting wage. And when we saw a 65% increase in owner-surrendered dogs in the first six months of 2022, we started looking for ways to provide even greater post-adoption behavioral and medical support. Ultimately, it inspires us to continue working toward a promising future for the pets and people of northern Colorado.

Join us in celebrating another year of everyday moments and their lifelong impact. Without fail, your support, encouragement, and partnership continue to make these moments possible.

Bambi

Finds Her Family Through Adoption

Bambi arrived at our shelter in early June of 2022 and immediately captured the hearts of our staff and volunteers. Though her playful and friendly demeanor spread joy throughout the shelter, seven-year-old Bambi was struggling with thyroid disease, allergies, and joint pain. Perhaps this is why, a month and a half later, Bambi was still on the hunt for a new family.

Meanwhile, Erie resident Suzanne had recently said goodbye to her 16-year-old Golden Retriever, Mandy. Suzanne and Mandy's bond was priceless, especially after spending eight years adventuring together on Suzanne's ranch. Despite living with horses and several acres of land, Mandy's passing created a void in Suzanne's heart, making her home feel empty.

For weeks, Suzanne toyed with the idea of bringing a new companion into her life. It wasn't until the moment she saw Bambi's photo and bio online, that she made up her mind. Her Golden Retriever, Mandy, was eight years old, and had been passed over for adoption time and time again when Suzanne found her. To find Bambi — a middle-aged, yellow Lab/Retriever mix, struggling to find a home — felt serendipitous.

Suzanne hopped on I-25 and drove to Larimer Humane Society. She walked straight to the service counter and said "I want to adopt Bambi." Moments later and without hesitation, Bambi trotted down the hallway and leaped into Suzanne's car, embarking on a new journey in Erie.

Bambi got acquainted with Suzanne, the ranch, and the horses very quickly. Only days after moving in, Bambi became comfortable sharing space with the horses and now drinks out of the same trough. Once a homeless, lonely Lab, Bambi now lives the dream of a ranch dog with a family to call her own. "I give her respect, and time to feel comfortable and settle in," said Suzanne. "I've learned that in doing so, she will give back what I can't buy — loyalty and love."

Bucky

Receives Critical Care from Veterinary Services

When Bucky arrived at Larimer Humane Society, we suspected right away that something was wrong. He refused to walk and was extremely reactive to touch near his front legs. After performing a radiograph, we learned that Bucky's leg was broken entirely in two. Four hours later, he was in surgery to amputate his leg.

Bucky's first post-surgical challenge was learning to walk with only three legs, which he mastered on walks with volunteers and potential adopters. Meanwhile, Anna from Fort Collins was perusing adoption sites online and scrolled across the seven-month-old tripod. She immediately drove to Larimer Humane Society, and that was the day that Bucky found his new home.

"I was going through some health issues at the time," said Anna, "so to find Bucky who was dealing with his share of medical issues, I figured, we can help each other out." Despite his missing limb, Bucky can keep up with any dog at the dog park, and loves to go

swimming. "I'm pretty sure he doesn't even know he has a disability," said Anna.

While he may not be limited by his missing leg, he does seem to realize that it's gone. Anna reported that Bucky chews off a single limb from each of his toys that have arms and legs — just one, so that they match how he looks — and then continues to play with them.

Almost one year later and Bucky's incision has healed up nicely. His surgery was one of three scheduled on that day, and thanks to Larimer Humane Society's veterinary services team, each of those three animals was given a second chance. For Bucky, it means that he can be the dog he was meant to be — an energetic companion who jumps, runs, swims, and greets everyone with a happy, slobbery smile. "Adopting Bucky has surpassed all my expectations in every way, shape, and form, in the best way."

Phineas

Journeys Home with the Transfer Program

Residents of Colorado are no strangers to wildfires. We understand that fighting a wildfire can require a network of support that reaches beyond county, or even state lines. That's why we were quick to respond to the need of animal welfare organizations in New Mexico as they confronted the historic Calf Canyon/Hermits Peak wildfire. In May of 2022, Larimer Humane Society was one of three Colorado animal shelters that took part in an emergency ground transfer to ensure the safety and wellbeing of 20 cats displaced by the 350,000-acre wildfire.

One of those cats was Phineas, a gray tabby kitten with loads of personality. At only two months old, Phineas set out on a 400-mile journey from Santa Fe to northern Colorado. On his arrival, Larimer Humane Society's transfer staff worked tirelessly into the night to ensure that Phineas and his friends each received an intake exam and a clean kennel to call home. Only 24 hours later, Phineas found himself on yet another journey — albeit brief — to the home of a loving foster family. At 1.7 pounds, Phineas was still too small to undergo the neuter surgery he would need to be eligible for adoption.

With so much going on — new environment, new peers, and new humans — Phineas remained curious and spunky as he settled into his new home in the Rocky Mountains. From peeking his head around every corner, to playing with every toy at his disposal, Phineas made the most of his time with the foster family until he gained enough weight to make his way to the adoption floor. It was no surprise when Phineas found his forever family after only one day back at the shelter.

Whether it's the result of a natural disaster or a partner shelter that's simply overcrowded, Larimer Humane Society's transfer program works every day to facilitate the best outcomes for animals around the country. This year, Phineas was one of more than 500 pets that set out on a journey to ultimately call northern Colorado 'home.'

Kya Gets a Helping Hand from Animal Protection & Control

Kya, an Australian Cattle dog, suffered multiple blows to the head at the hand of her owner. After a third party alerted our Animal Protection & Control (APC) team, the two-year-old was removed from the home and brought to Larimer Humane Society for immediate medical attention. Shortly thereafter, our APC officers learned that the wounds on Kya's head were due to blunt force from a cast iron griddle.

After a thorough examination, wound treatment, and a prescribed regimen to manage her pain and swelling, Kya was able to settle in for some much needed rest and recovery. For the next three months, she remained in Larimer Humane Society's care while her owner awaited trial. It wasn't until February 10 that Kya was formally surrendered to us. Six days later, Kya found her new person.

Sydney discovered Kya in the shelter and was quickly drawn to her. After a couple of visits over the course of a week, Sydney knew that Kya was meant to be part of her family. "Kya has adjusted wonderfully to her new home," said Sydney. "Her and her brother

Maverick got along almost instantly and are now two peas in a pod." Maverick even seems to be helping Kya's struggle with separation anxiety. "She is so eager to please and is full of love!" Said Sydney. "Our vet said that she is perfectly healthy and that her wound has healed beautifully. We are so lucky to have her in the family."

For our APC officers, the day that Kya was brought to the shelter for medical attention was just another day in the field. For Kya, it was lifesaving. And for Sydney, it was life changing. As for Kya's former owner, they've been held accountable for their actions and are learning how to appropriately interact with and care for animals. In just one day, our APC team indisputably altered the lives of three community members — making northern Colorado a safer place for pets and people, and giving Kya the second chance that she so deserved.

Bugsy Gives New Life in Foster Care

Bugsy was barely a year old when her owner realized that 'she' was not a 'he.' Not only that, she was pregnant! Recognizing that they would be unable to care for a litter of newborn guinea pigs (called pups), Bugsy's owner entrusted her to Larimer Humane Society. Staff immediately set out to find the perfect foster family to see Bugsy through her pregnancy. That's when our veteran volunteer and foster enthusiast Molly raised her hand.

"Bugsy was just the sweetest thing from the moment she arrived," said Molly. "She loved to sit in our laps and eat lettuce, and when she could hear us humans talking, she joined in and chortled with adorable sounds. She arrived at our home on April 9 and the babies were born on April 28. Bugsy vocalized a sound that I had not heard before, and 30 minutes later, seven babies were born. The pups were ADORABLE. I learned that guinea pig babies are just about the cutest sight ever — born with eyes and ears open, fur, teeth, etc. — as if they looked like miniature adults."

"Bugsy was a champ — she immediately cleaned up her pups and took on the 'mama' role. We gave Bugsy the opportunity to sit in our lap twice a day to eat her veggie meals, but, unlike before she gave birth, she would take the lettuce, climb off our laps, and back into the enclosure with her pups. She was a very good mama!"

"I love animals and I love my family, and fostering with Larimer Humane Society combines the two! My husband and our 14-year old son were heavily involved with this foster stay since eight guinea pigs can create quite the mess — we all helped with water, food, cleanings, and socializing them. We brought them back to the shelter on May 22, just less than a month after Bugsy gave birth, and were confident that Bugsy and her cute pups would have no problem getting adopted."

Whether caring for pregnant guinea pigs, newborn kittens, or under-socialized dogs, each and every day, volunteers like Molly are working to better the lives of homeless pets in our community, one foster animal (or in this case, eight) at a time.

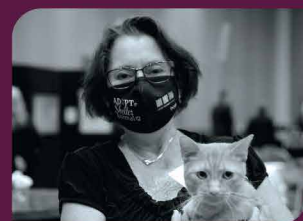
