All dogs are lovingly cared for at Larimer Humane Society and provided with a general medical examination and testing for good health. Your adoption fee also includes:

- Preliminary vaccinations
- Microchip implant and registration
- Collar and leash for safe travel home
- Spay or neuter surgery
- Complimentary post-adoption medical exam from a participating veterinary clinic
- Complimentary first month of pet health insurance
- Discount on your first purchase from Poudre Pet & Feed Supply

As we approach summer and experience warmer weather, this is typically the time we see an uptick in adoptable animals at the shelter. With animals coming in faster than they are being adopted, this promotion helps to ensure that fees are not a barrier to adoption, and that our adoptable dogs can find the home they deserve just in time for summer.
