This letter is to advise you that the animal(s) residing at your residence have been causing excessive or untimely noise by barking, howling or baying excessively. This noise has caused a disturbance to me and possibly others residing in the neighborhood.

I have downloaded this letter from NOCO Humane's website to inform you of the situation. Since dogs tend to cause a greater disturbance when their owners are not home, I thought you would like to be informed of the disturbance.

I hope you can rectify the situation, and that we can resolve this issue amicably before an official complaint is made with NOCO Humane's Animal Protection & Control Department.

To further aid you in helping your pet, I will be recording the days and times that your pet(s) is creating a disturbance to the neighborhood. If you would like, I can supply you with a list of these days and times to see if they correspond with times you are away from your home.

Please be aware that the Town of Wellington's municipal code has ordinances pertaining to animal disturbance of peace and quiet. To read the ordinance in its entirety, please visit code section 7-4-630 Noise and 7-4-630 Habitually barking dogs. You can find links to the full code at www.nocohumane.org under the Animal Protection & Control tab for the Town of Wellington.

NOCO Humane's website also includes tips on how you can successfully work with your animal to successfully curb excessive noise. They have some wonderful tips sheets posted on their website.
