NOCO HUMANE TO OPEN NEW CAMPUS IN 2025

We are excited to announce that NOCO Humane will be expanding its operations with the opening of the NOCO Humane Greeley Adoption Campus in 2025! Located near the corner of 65th Ave. and Hwy 34 in Greeley, CO, this new facility will be dedicated solely to pet adoptions to help even more homeless animals find families in northern Colorado.

NOCO Humane purchased the building in November of 2023. A former doggie daycare, it is currently being renovated to better support future services, and is expected to open to the public in early 2025.

In October of 2023, when NOCO Humane agreed to take over operations of the facility formerly owned by the Humane Society of Weld County, it was immediately clear that a new shelter would need to be built in Weld County – similar to NOCO Humane's Larimer Campus – to address the issue of space.

Knowing this endeavor would require years of planning and fundraising, the organization's leadership began looking at options to immediately increase animal capacity and overall space. The first solution involved installing two modular units to the lot, allowing more space for cat kennels and staff workspace. The second solution – you guessed it – the purchase of a new facility to increase capacity.

"Around the time we were discussing the issue of space in Weld County, the Sirius Dog Daycare facility was up for sale," says Judy Calhoun, NOCO Humane CEO. "So we started looking at that building more seriously and whether it would provide us with additional space." After investigating the facility, NOCO Humane moved forward with the investment.

"The idea is to make this building an 'adoption center," says Calhoun. "Not to stop doing adoptions at our Weld Campus in Evans, but to make this a supplementary adoption campus. This adds a bit more space and helps us move more animals into the community."

The fact that this building was already constructed to house and care for animals is a major benefit. "We're not having to retro-fit, not having to put in additional drains," says Calhoun. "While the renovations are not inexpensive, they are far less than they would have been with a former office building. There's already a laundry room, outdoor play yards, food prep areas, dog kennels, and an existing lobby."

The Greeley Adoption Campus is 4,000 square feet and will provide space for approximately 100 animals: about 30 dogs, 60 cats, and 10 small mammals. "It will be quieter and less stressful for the animals awaiting their forever homes," said Calhoun. "We also hope this building will allow us to accept more owner-surrenders at the Weld Campus."

NOCO Humane began renovations this summer and handed the responsibilities of design, permitting, and renovation to a local company, Neenan Archistruction. "We chose them to handle everything so that our facilities team could continue to focus on our Larimer and Weld shelter campuses," said Calhoun.

Renovations include: adding two visit rooms, creating space for three banks of cat condos, installing an ADA accessible bathroom, upgrading some of the open spaces and kennels, replacing sinks and counter tops, adding an equipment wash station, installing a washer, dryer, and dishwasher, landscaping out front, taking down two exterior structures, and renovating the outdoor dog runs.

The work is underway and NOCO Humane is excited to increase its capacity to care for animals in need. As we all know, major changes such as these come with a cost, and NOCO Humane cannot achieve this vital


project without your generous support. "We are hosting a small capital campaign for \$250,000," says Calhoun. "While that won't pay for the entire renovation, it will certainly support some of the costs." By contributing, you will directly impact the lives of homeless pets in northern Colorado. 


